Dear Parents:

This letter is to inform you that a student from Hopkins High School was recently diagnosed with COVID-19 and is currently at home in isolation. The Allegan County Health Department (ACHD) is investigating the situation and all close contacts are being notified through a separate letter and will be home in quarantine.

Due to widespread infections with COVID-19 within our community, the ACHD recommends parents continue to assess their children prior to leaving home. Symptoms to be watching for are (new/different/worse from baseline of any chronic illness):

1. Temperature 100.4 or higher signs of fever (chills/sweating)
2. Sore throat
3. Uncontrolled cough
4. Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
5. Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain
6. Severe headache
7. Loss of taste or smell

It is recommended that your child be tested for COVID-19 if they get any of these symptoms. You can call 2-1-1 or go to [www.michigan.gov/coronavirustest](http://www.michigan.gov/coronavirustest) for testing locations.
