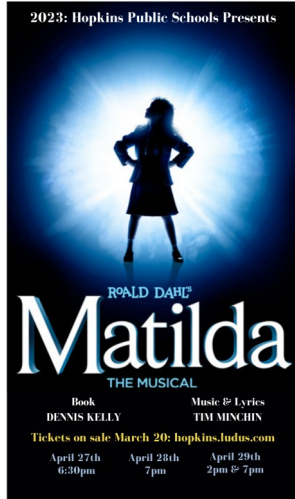

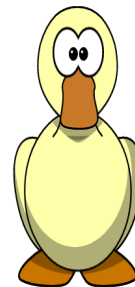

CELL PHONES AT SCHOOL

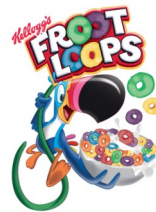
