NOTICE OF VACANCY

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Interested citizens must meet the legal requirements to be a member of the Board of Education. They must be at least 18 years of age; a citizen of the United States; a resident of the State of Michigan and a resident of the Hopkins Public Schools district; a register voter in the school district.

Interested citizens should send a letter expressing their interest to Mrs. Karen Ryan, Secretary, Board of Education, Hopkins Public Schools, 400 Street, Hopkins, Michigan 49328. This letter must be received in the Superintendent's Office no later than 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 9, 2020.

In the letter of interest please include the following information:

- Full name, address, telephone number;
- Personal background relevant to serving on a public school board;
- Cite the reason(s) why you are interested in serving on the school board;
- Comment on educational issues or concerns facing the Hopkins Public Schools as you view them and possible means of resolving those issues or concerns;
- Whether you wish under Section 8F, of Michigan's Open Meetings Act that your application remain confidential, however; be advised that while your application remains confidential, you may need to be identified as the Board of Education deliberates and decides upon the matter of filling the vacancy by vote in public session;
- Personal signature of applicant on letter of interest.

The Board of Education will convene in public session to interview candidates for this vacancy at a date/time to be determined.
