Mrs. Evans' Classroom Supply List

Here is a list of items 3rd graders will use on a regular basis. If you are able, please send in all of these items with your son/daughter on the first day of school. We do have extra classroom supplies if you are unable to provide these for your 3rd grader.

- *crayons**
- *Pencils (12-18)**
- *erasers**
- *colored pencils**
- *Glue sticks (4-6)**
- *scissors**
- *1 pack of loose leaf (wide ruled) paper**
- *1 pack of dry erase markers**
- *1 hard pencil box to keep supplies in**
- * 1 folder**
- *Headphones**
- *1-2 boxes of tissues**
- *Clorox/Lysol Wipes**

The first day of school we will spend time organizing our supplies, making sure everything fits nicely in our desk. Any extra supplies will be kept in the cupboard so that I can pass out extras as kids need them. I will have a folder our 3rd graders will be bringing back and forth to school each day, but they will need one (their choice) to house unfinished work throughout the day. Mechanical pencils are not recommended for 3rd graders. They can become a pretty big distraction.
