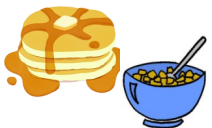

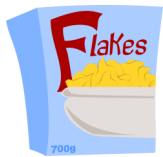
HOPKINS ELEMENTARY DRIVES

FOOD DRIVE

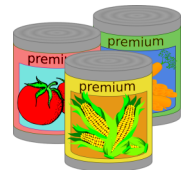
