WINTER WARMTH DRIVE & FOOD DRIVE

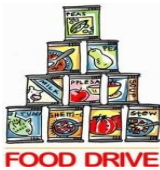
Gently Used or New Winter Clothing

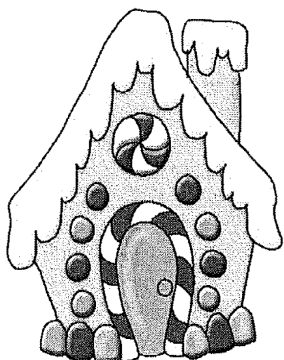
