Your child must be 5 by September 1, 2025.

Please take your time & fill out all forms. You will also need to upload necessary pieces of information including birth certificate, proof of residency, immunization records. More information is provided on the Final Forms site.

After you've finished your Final Forms, call to schedule screening & orientation for your child (in April & May, respectively).

Your child is NOT considered enrolled until all Final Forms criteria is completed.
