



Suggestions given by the Allegan County Health Dept. of "When to Keep Your Child Home":

*Severely Ill

*Fever: Temp. of 101F or greater AND behavior changes
or other signs and symptoms (keep home until 24 hours
fever-free, without use of fever-reducing meds)

*Diarrhea: no loose stools for 24 hrs. prior to returning==

*Vomiting: no vomiting episodes for 24 hrs. prior to
returning==

*Rash: with fever or change in behavior==

*Skin sores (weeping sores that can't be covered with
waterproof dressing)

*Certain Communicable Diseases: may need to be
excluded

==These are general recommendations only. Consult physician
or local public health department.
