


Enroll in the Great Start Readiness Program!

In summer 2021, Governor Gretchen Whitmer and the state legislature agreed on a bipartisan expansion of the Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP), Michigan's nationally recognized preschool program for **four-year-old children**.
