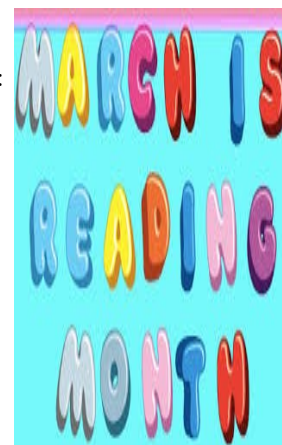

The Gun Lake Tribe is able to offer an after-school program
twice weekly to Hopkins students of Native American descent
with one-on-one tutoring provided by highly qualified educa-
tors, homework help, academic & cultural-based enrichment
activities, culture & language activities & snacks.

If your child is a 1st-12th grade student & they are a Tribal
Citizen of any federally recognized Tribe OR they have a par-
ent or grandparent who is a citizen of a federally recognized
Tribe, they are eligible for services. Eligibility forms & infor-
