- Fluently add within 20
- Fluently subtract within 20
- Read and write numbers to 1,000
- Compare two 3-digit numbers
- Understand hundreds, tens & ones
- Fluently add within 100
- Fluently subtract within 100
- Mentally add or subtract 10 or 100 to any number 100-900
- Measure an object's length using appropriate tools
- Recognize and draw shapes with specific attributes

Reading

- Comprehend what is read
- Read accurately at grade level
- Read fluently and with expression

Writing

- Write a narrative piece
- Write an opinion piece
- Write an informational piece
- Use correct capitalization in written work
- Use correct punctuation in written work
- Express ideas clearly and completely in written work
- Understand and apply the writing process as taught
- Understand and apply proper grammar
