MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR YOUR CHILD(REN) THESE DAYS!!!

Medications...

If your child needs medications at school, be certain to go to Final Forms to fill out the necessary form.

For prescription medication, a doctor signature is required.

Please bring medications into the office (not with students), in their original package.

Suggestions given by the Allegan County Health Dept. of "When to Keep Your Child Home":

- *Severely III
- *Fever: Temp. of 101F or greater AND behavior changes or other signs and symptoms (keep home until 24 hours fever-free, without use of fever-reducing meds)
- *Diarrhea: no loose stools for 24 hrs. prior to returning==
- *Vomiting: no vomiting episodes for 24 hrs. prior to returning==
- *Rash: with fever or change in behavior==
- *Skin sores (weeping sores that can't be covered with waterproof dressing)
- *Certain Communicable Diseases: may need to be excluded
- ==These are general recommendations only. Consult physician or local public health department.
