#### Medications...

- If your child needs medications at school, be certain to go to Final Forms to fill out the necessary form.
- For prescription medication, a doctor signature is required.

Please bring medications into the office (not with students), in their original package.

## Suggestions given by the Allegan County Health Dept. of "When to Keep Your Child Home":

- \*Severely III
- \*Fever: Temp. of 101F or greater AND behavior changes or other signs and symptoms (keep home until 24 hours fever-free, without use of fever-reducing meds)
- \*Diarrhea: no loose stools for 24 hrs. prior to returning==
- \*Vomiting: no vomiting episodes for 24 hrs. prior to returning==
- \*Rash: with fever or change in behavior==
- \*Skin sores (weeping sores that can't be covered with waterproof dressing)
- \*Certain Communicable Diseases: may need to be excluded
- ==These are general recommendations only. Consult physician or local public health department.
