- Count to 30 by ones
- Write numbers to 10
- Identify numbers 0-20
- Count to tell the number of objects up to 20
- Compare sets of objects <, >, or =
- Recognize 5 basic shapes
- Recognize and extend patterns
- Represent addition within 5
- Sort objects by color
- Sort objects by shape
- Sort objects by size

Reading

- Recognize first name
- Recognize last name
- Recognize and create rhymes
- Sequence a story (beginning, middle, end)
- Identify words that begin with the same sound
- Recognize uppercase letters
- Recognize lowercase letters
- Identify letter sounds
- Read CVC words
- Read 15 sight words
- Read level A books with or without support

Writing

- Print most uppercase letters
- Print most lowercase letters
- Print first name
- Draw and label pictures to tell a story
